SUBJECT: American Rescue Plan Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief
(ARP ESSER)

In the ARP ESSER memorandum dated, May 25, 2021, the Alabama State Department of Education (ALSDE) provided the fund allocation amounts to local education agencies (LEAs) for the required 90% portion that must be awarded to LEAs.

In addition to the required 90 percent portion to LEAs under the ARP ESSER, states must reserve portions of its ten percent of the total ARP ESSER allocation for activities and interventions that respond to students' academic, social, and emotional needs and address the disproportionate impact of COVID-19 on underrepresented student subgroups.

The state-level reservations are to be used for the following:

- Five (5) percent of the total ARP ESSER allocation for the implementation of evidence-based interventions aimed specifically at addressing learning loss, such as summer learning or summer enrichment, extended day, comprehensive afterschool programs, or extended school year programs.
- One (1) percent of the total ARP ESSER allocation for evidence-based summer enrichment programs.
- One (1) percent of the total ARP ESSER allocation for evidence-based comprehensive afterschool programs.

The ALSDE will subgrant the state-level portion of the state reservation to the LEAs. Plans for use of the funds must be in accordance with the specific purpose outlined above. Attached you will find the allocation amounts for each area: learning loss, summer enrichment, and afterschool programs. The learning loss allocation is to be used for the Fiscal Year (FY) 2022 and FY 2023 Summer Reading Program to address K-3 literacy.

There is not a separate application for these ARP ESSER state reserve funds. The current ARP ESSER electronic Grant Application Process (eGAP) application contains a section dedicated to outline the intended use of these funds by the LEA. As a reminder, eGAP applications for ARP ESSER funds are due August 23, 2021.
