Grant Requirements

- 1. Preliminary Budget/Certification Page—Each LEA must complete the preliminary budget page. The maximum grant award will be \$25,000.00. Each LEA must submit an original Certification Cover Page. Each LEA must mark its Workforce Region on each page. (10 Points)
- 2. Project Narrative—Each LEA must demonstrate a plan to expand Career and Technical Education Programs. (30 Points)
- 3. Labor Market Data—Each LEA must supply Labor Market Data to support the project. (15 Points)
- 4. Career and Technical Education Data Page—Each LEA must submit a Career and Technical Education Data Page. Preference will be given to LEAs with higher socio-economic percentage. (45 Points)

Up to four grants will be awarded per Workforce Region.

Project Narrative

- 1. Describe the Career and Technical Education program to be expanded.
- 2. Describe how the program expansion will create equity and access.
- 3. Describe how the success of the program will be measured.

Labor Market Data

- 1. List of three high-wage and/or in-demand occupations for program to be expanded.
- 2. Number of jobs for each occupation listed in the immediate area of LEA.
