RE: Alabama Kindergarten Inventory of Developing Skills (AlaKiDS)

The Alabama State Department of Education (ALSDE) is pleased to announce a partnership with the Alabama Department of Early Childhood Education (DECE) to support the implementation of a statewide kindergarten entry inventory or measure for all students entering kindergarten for the upcoming 2020-2021 school year. Pursuant to *Alabama* Code § 26-24-23, the Alabama Kindergarten Inventory of Developing Skills, also referred to as AlaKiDS, is intentionally designed to help kindergarten teachers efficiently collect information during the beginning of the school year to assess kindergarten readiness by identifying student knowledge, skills, and behaviors.

With the impact of COVID-19, the Alabama education community has worked collaboratively to provide educators and families with additional readiness tools and resources to identify and close achievement and other gaps in the early learning development of a child. Many of Alabama's early learning programs, other care programs, and families' livelihoods have been disrupted, which has placed many Alabama children at risk of entering kindergarten behind the widely held expectation, negated the opportunity to gather end-of-year data, and impacted the transition programs for incoming kindergarten students. As a result, the DECE and ALSDE state and regional staff have partnered to assist all Alabama elementary schools with the training needed and the initial administration of AlaKiDS to all students entering kindergarten this fall.

Regional coaches, local coaches, and kindergarten teachers will be provided virtual training in July 2020 (see attachments), and all related supplies and materials will be provided for the teachers by the DECE. AlaKiDS should be administered to **all** kindergarten students within the first three-to-four weeks of the start of the school year. Following the initial year of AlaKiDS implementation, system coaches will provide training to new hires, as well as continue providing additional support through regional and local coaches.
