RE: English Learner (EL) Education Program Allocations for Fiscal Year (FY) 2023

The FY 2023 state funding to improve existing English Learner services has been approved. Attached you will find the allocations. These funds have been allocated to ensure that English language learners receive high-quality instruction. In order to facilitate an understanding of the most effective way to allocate these funds, it is incumbent upon the Alabama State Department of Education (ALSDE) to ensure that local education agencies (LEAs) clearly understand how to achieve the highest English Learner Education Return on Investment (EL-ROI). The choices to maximize your EL-ROI are listed below:

1. English learner classroom teacher units
2. Professional development for high-quality content and language instruction
3. Resources/materials in the home languages of students to integrate their use into lessons
4. Evidence-based services to meet the needs of all learners
5. Technology for EL programs
6. District-level support

The EL education funding must be used to add to or improve the EL program and not to supplant already existing services or materials. The budget of each LEA will be pulled for audit purposes annually by ALSDE personnel to ensure the most effective use of its allocation based on LEA data.
