RE: Fiscal Year (FY) 2023 and FY 2024 Elementary Reading and Math Assessments Schedule and Funding Information

FY 2024 marks the first year of implementation of the screeners and assessments for reading (K-3) and math (K-5) as required by the *Alabama Literacy Act (ALA)* and the *Alabama Numeracy Act (ANA)*. The ANA expanded the administration of the Early Years Assessments (EYA) to Grades 4-5 and added two screener administration windows for the Early Numeracy Screeners (Grades K-2) and Fractional Reasoning Screeners (Grades 4-5). This memo includes the administration schedule and funding information for these screeners and assessments, including start-up funds for this year's administration of the ANA Assessments from FY 2023 funds, as was previously done with the EYA. An upcoming memo will share a comprehensive list of recommendations from the Elementary Mathematics Task Force.

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Funding, Allocations, and Requirements:

Early Years Assessments (EYA):

Local education agencies (LEAs) will be allocated \$6 per pupil for Grades K-3 Reading and K-5 Math for the EYA.

- EYA Math Grades K-3 Fund Source – Special Use Code: 1262-0043
- EYA Reading Grades K-3 Fund Source – Special Use Code: 1262-0044

Math Screeners:

LEAs will be allocated \$6 per pupil for Grades K-2 and Grades 4-5 Math Screeners

- Early Numeracy Screener Grades K-2 Fund Source – Special Use Code: 1232-0041 (additional start-up funds provided).
- Fractional Reasoning Screener Grades 4-5 Fund Source – Special Use Code: 1232-0042 (additional start-up funds provided).
- EYA Math Grades 4-5 Fund Source – Special Use Code: 1232-0040 (additional start-up funds provided).

The per-pupil allocation will be based on the previous fiscal year's average daily membership (ADM) and **is contingent on meeting the requirements listed below**. Allocations calculated on FY 2023 ADM are attached.

Requirements for Funding:

1. Select one approved assessment from each category (Early Years Assessment, Early Numeracy Screener, and Fractional Reasoning Screener) to be used for Alabama State Department of Education (ALSDE) data reporting.
2. Spend funds only on items directly related to the screeners and assessments.
3. Set up an account and create class rosters with each vendor prior to the EYA-BOY testing window.
4. Administer each screener or assessment according to the published guidelines and testing windows.
5. Complete data reporting agreements with vendors allowing direct data reporting to the ALSDE.
6. Ensure that data reports and any additional reports are complete and submitted by deadlines.
7. Funds are set to be released in two installments with payments in January and July of 2024.
8. Additional start-up funds for Math Grades 4-5, Early Numeracy Screeners, and Fractional Reasoning Screeners will be released prior to October 1, 2023.
