

ALABAMA SPECIAL EDUCATION ADVISORY PANEL

SEAP MEMBERSHIP DEFINED:

The membership of the Alabama Special Education Advisory Panel (SEAP) is defined in the provisions of 20 USC section 1412(a)(21) and 34 CFR section 300.167 – 300.168: *The State must establish and maintain an advisory panel for the purpose of providing policy guidance with respect to special education and related services for children with disabilities in the State.*

Membership must include the following:

- *Parent* - Parents of children with disabilities (ages birth through 26),
- *IWD* - Individuals with disabilities,
- *Teachers* – Teachers,
- *IHE* – Reps of IHE’s that prepare special education and related services personnel,
- *ALSDE/LEA* – State and LEA officials, including McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act,
- *ADM* – Administrators of programs for children with disabilities,
- *OSA* – Rep of other state agencies involved in the financing or delivery of related services to children with disabilities,
- *PS/CS* - Representative of Private Schools and public Charter Schools,
- *TRANS* - Representatives of a business organization concerned with the provision of transition services,
- *FOSTER* - Representatives of the Department of Human Resources or Foster Care,
- *CORR* - Representative of State juvenile and Adult corrections agencies.
