

## ***Suicide School Faculty & Staff Training***

### **Introduction:**

This training was developed by the Alabama State Department of Education Suicide Prevention Advisory Committee in early 2021. This training is to provide basic knowledge on suicide and the three levels of engagement and to support the Local Education Agency's policy on suicide.
