GENERAL INFORMATION

An applicant whose degree was earned at a college or university in another country that is not a United States (U.S.) Territory and is seeking Alabama certification must obtain an evaluation of his/her credentials from a foreign credential evaluation agency approved by the Alabama State Department of Education (ALSDE). A listing of approved agencies may be found in the <u>AGENCIES PROVIDING EVALUATION SERVICES</u> section of this form. The evaluation must be submitted with the application for certification and must include **all** of the following:

- 1. An accurate course-by-course and credit hour-by-credit hour translation of the coursework completed.
- 2. A statement indicating at the time the degree was earned the college or university did or did not hold accreditation equivalent to that granted by a regional accrediting agency in the United States.
- 3. A statement indicating the degree earned was or was not equivalent to a bachelor's or higher degree conferred by a regionally accredited senior institution in the United States.
- 4. A statement indicating the program completed was or was not equivalent to an educator preparation program in the United States. If the program was equivalent to an educator preparation program, the specific teaching field must be identified. If the program was not equivalent to an educator preparation program, the major(s) of the program must be identified.
 - 1. A statement indicating the overall grade point average (GPA) on a 4.0-point scale. The overall GPA must be the GPA that was used as the basis for granting the degree.

AGENCIES PROVIDING EVALUATION SERVICES

The ALSDE does not interpret foreign credentials but relies on certain agencies to provide an analysis of the applicant's records to assist in correctly interpreting those records. The applicant must forward records to the agency which will produce an analysis of the credentials for a fee. The agencies that are approved for certification purposes in Alabama are:

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APPROACHES TO ALABAMA CERTIFICATION FOR APPLICANTS WHO HOLD DEGREES FROM COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES IN OTHER COUNTRIES THAT ARE NOT U.S. TERRITORIES

- 1. An applicant who has completed an educator preparation program in a teaching field and has earned a degree at a college or university in another country that is not a U.S. Territory, may apply for Alabama professional educator certification through the Foreign Credentials Approach as directed on this Form APF. The degree must be equivalent to at least a bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited senior institution in the United States. If Alabama issues a certificate in a teaching field that is comparable to the educator preparation program completed, the appropriate Professional Educator Certificate may be issued after requirements have been met. You may only submit this application if you meet this option.
- 2. An applicant who has earned a degree at a college or university in another country that is not a U.S. Territory, and that degree is equivalent to at least a bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited senior institution in the United States, and also holds a valid professional educator certificate issued by another state, the District of Columbia, a U.S. Territory, or the Department of Defense Education Activity (DoDEA) may apply for Alabama professional educator certification through the Certificate Reciprocity Approach. Information regarding this approach may be found on Form OTH at www.alabamaachieves.org/ (click Teachers & Administrators Teacher Center Teacher Certification Out of State Certificates). The evaluation prepared by a foreign credential evaluation agency approved by the ALSDE must be submitted with the application.
- 3. An applicant who **has not** completed an educator preparation program but has earned a degree at a college or university in another country that is not a U.S. Territory, and that degree is equivalent to at least a bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited senior institution in the United States may pursue Alabama certification through the approaches below. Each approach requires the evaluation prepared by a foreign credential evaluation agency approved by the ALSDE be submitted with the application.
 - Completion of a State-approved educator preparation program at an Alabama college or university. Application for Alabama professional educator certification is made in conjunction with the Alabama college or university upon completion of the program. Information regarding State-approved programs in Alabama may be found at www.alabamaachieves.org/ (click *Teachers & Administrators & Teacher Center & Teacher Preparation Programs*).
 - Completion of an alternative or provisional certification approach through an Alabama local school system or nonpublic/private school. Application for an alternative or provisional certificate is made in conjunction with an Alabama local school system or nonpublic/private school. Application for Alabama professional educator certification is made by the applicant upon completion of the approach. - 4. An applicant whose bachelor's degree was earned at a college or university in another country that was not a U.S. Territory at the time the degree was earned and the degree was **not** equivalent to at least a bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited senior institution in the United States OR the university did **not** have accreditation equivalent to that granted by a regional accrediting agency in the United States, must earn a bachelor's or higher degree from a regionally accredited senior institution in the United States. Certification through another approach may be pursued once an acceptable degree is earned.

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APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS and CHECKLIST

APPLICATION FORMS AND SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS ARE NOT ACCEPTED BY FAX OR E-MAIL.

An application packet for Alabama certification must include the items listed below:

Application Forms

- Submission of Supplement CIT Form with supporting documentation verifying United States citizenship or lawful presence in the United States.
- Submission of this application Form APF.

Nonrefundable Application Fee

- A \$38.00 *nonrefundable* application fee. Each additional certificate for which an applicant is determined to be eligible will require a \$38.00 nonrefundable fee for issuance. **Neither personal checks nor cash will be accepted.**
- The fee must be paid by cashier's check <u>or</u> money order made payable to the Alabama State Department of Education (ALSDE) or through the <u>ALSDE Educator Certification Online Payment System</u>, with a major credit card, (a transaction fee will be applied).
- The cashier's check, money order, or copy of the receipt verifying the confirmation number for the online payment must accompany the application packet.

Background Clearance

- Background clearance based on a fingerprint review.
- For applicants seeking **initial certification**, **additional certification**, **or certificate renewal** to teach in Alabama, your criminal history background checks must have been completed by both the Alabama State Bureau of Investigation (ASBI) and the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI). You can check the status of your background checks and confirm whether you meet the state's suitability requirements for teaching at https://tcert.alsde.edu/Portal.
- For Applicants who have not been cleared by both agencies through the Educator Certification Section of the Alabama State Department of Education (ALSDE), you will need to undergo fingerprinting for a criminal history background check. Individuals who choose to test prior to receiving a letter of eligibility from the Educator Certification Section of the ALSDE do so at their own risk.
