## RESOLUTION TO APPROVE EDUCATOR PREPARATION PROGRAMS Alabama State University (ASU)

**WHEREAS**, Alabama Administrative Code, Rule No. 290-3-3-.59(3), allows a program leading to an Alabama Professional Educator Certificate be approved through the Continuous Improvement in Educator Preparation (CIEP) program review process; and

- **WHEREAS**, Alabama State University had a CAEP site visit in November 2021 and was granted continuing accreditation until June 30, 2029; and
- **WHEREAS**, Alabama State University submitted programs through the CIEP review process during the August 2023 CIEP review session; and
- **WHEREAS,** during the program review, all programs submitted were deemed met with conditions or met pending a few clarifications; and
- **WHEREAS**, a review team visited Alabama State University for discovery and clarification on March 7, 2024; and
- **WHEREAS,** Alabama State University has selected a new vendor for its Quality Assurance System and displayed its plans to move forward with the new system for data management; and
- **WHEREAS**, Alabama State University was able to address all concerns during the onsite review of programs and documented compliance with all standards for the programs submitted; and
- WHEREAS, Alabama State University submitted a progress report in September 2023 (i.e., revised course syllabi, matrix of program progression, evidence of faculty training in the

Science of Reading, evidence of newly adopted textbooks, etc.) detailing their efforts toward meeting the Alabama Literacy Act and the recommendations provided by Barksdale Institution for Science of Literacy; and

WHEREAS, the Alabama literacy review team examined the evidence presented by Alabama State University and determined that significant progress has been made toward implementing the Alabama Literacy Act requirements and recommendations submitted by Barksdale: and

WHEREAS, Alabama State University is engaged in a process of continuous improvement:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Alabama State Board of Education hereby grants approval of the following programs until June 30, 2031:
