RESOLUTION TO APPROVE EDUCATOR PREPARATION PROGRAMS The University of Alabama

WHEREAS, Alabama Administrative Code, Rule No. 290-3-3-.59(3), allows a program leading to an Alabama Professional Educator Certificate be approved through the Continuous Improvement in Educator Preparation (CIEP) program review process; and

- **WHEREAS**, The University of Alabama previously submitted CIEP documents in Fall of 2022 and based upon preliminary examination received denial of approval for all programs; and
- **WHEREAS,** on December 7, 2022, The University of Alabama deactivated Class B Latin (P-12), Latin (6-12), Alternative A French (6-12), French (P-12), German (6-12), German (P-12), Latin (6-12), and Latin (P-12) programs; and
- **WHEREAS**, The University of Alabama petitioned to have a follow-up review of previous submissions and an onsite visit in the Spring of 2023; and
- **WHEREAS**, The University of Alabama had all CIEPs reviewed during the Summer of 2023 and received met with conditions on several of the CIEPs, and
- **WHEREAS**, a review team visited The University of Alabama for discovery and clarification on February 12, 2024; and
- **WHEREAS,** The University of Alabama was able to address all concerns during the onsite review of programs and documented compliance with all standards for the programs submitted; and
- **WHEREAS**, The University of Alabama had a CAEP site visit in February 2023 and was granted full accreditation between October 22, 2023, and December 31, 2030; and
- **WHEREAS**, The University of Alabama submitted a progress report in September 2023 (i.e., revised course syllabi, matrix of program progression, evidence of faculty training in the Science of Reading, evidence of newly adopted textbooks, etc.) detailing their efforts toward meeting the *Alabama Literacy Act* and the recommendations provided by Barksdale Institution for Science of Literacy; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Alabama literacy review team examined the evidence presented by The University of Alabama and determined that significant progress has been made toward implementing the *Alabama Literacy Act* requirements and recommendations submitted by Barksdale; and
- **WHEREAS,** The University of Alabama is engaged in a process of continuous improvement:
- **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** That the Alabama State Board of Education hereby grants approval of the following programs until June 30, 2031:
