As stated in 3.1 Requirements of Proposal of the RFP, the evaluators want a cost proposal that includes the methods of calculation, concise explanation of each item listed in the cost proposal and total cost per administrative review which must include required site review(s) to conform with and conduct complete Administrative Reviews in accordance with the requirements described in the RFP.

5. What were the total number of administrative reviews and site visits required (if fewer were performed than required, please also note the number performed) for the Summer Feeding Program for the previous 2 years.

In the previous 2 years, 24 administrative reviews were conducted in 2024 and 38 administrative reviews were conducted in 2023.

Our system does not provide the total number of site reviews; therefore, the total number of site reviews is not available for the previous two years. Each administrative review would have included at least one site review. The majority of

the sponsors would have required three or less site reviews. The larger sponsor would have required nine site reviews.
