REVIEW OF THE DRAFTS 2024 ALABAMA COURSE OF STUDY: ARTS EDUCATION AND THE 2024 ALABAMA COURSE OF STUDY: SOCIAL STUDIES CALL FOR PUBLIC COMMENT

Montgomery, AL – Drafts of the 2024 *Alabama Course of Study: Arts Education* and the *Alabama Course of Study: Social Studies* were presented to the Alabama State Board of Education at the November 14, 2024, work session.

To ensure that the public has an opportunity to read and provide input into these standards, the Alabama State Department of Education (ALSDE) will receive public comment on the drafts of the 2024 *Alabama Course of Study: Arts Education* and the 2024 *Alabama Course of Study: Social Studies* until 5:00 p.m. on November 28, 2024.

To receive public input, the form for submitting public comments and a copy of the draft are being made available on the ALSDE website and will be posted from Thursday, November 14, 2024, through 5:00 p.m. Thursday, November 28, 2024.
