## Minimum Number of Students

Each indicator and subgroup must meet the minimum N-count of 20 to be included in the Accountability System’s calculations as a subgroup. Any school/system that does not have sufficient indicator data will not have points assigned. The school/system will receive a label of “ID” for “Insufficient Data”.

## Long-term Goals and Measures of Interim Progress

Long-term goals and measures of interim progress are also reported at the “All Students” level and for each subgroup of students that has a minimum of 20 students. Due to Alabama's approved amendment (August 15, 2023), the Alabama State Department of Education established new baseline data from the 2021-2022 school year and shifted its timeline for meeting long-term goals for Academic Achievement to 2034-2035 because it transitioned to a new statewide summative assessment. Long-term goals and measures of interim progress are provided for Academic Achievement, Graduation Rate, and Progress of English Language Proficiency as required by the *Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965* (ESEA), reauthorized as the *Every Student Succeeds Act* (ESSA).

### *Comprehensive Support and Improvement Schools (CSI)*

Alabama identifies schools for CSI support as follows:

- A Title I school whose total points are within the bottom 5% of total points of Title I schools;
- Any high schools (regardless of Title I status) that has a graduation rate less than 67%;
- Any Title I school with at least one chronically low subgroup of students that has not made sufficient improvement after implementation of a Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) plan over a maximum of three years.

### *Consistently Underperforming Schools – Targeted Support Schools (TSI) and Additional Targeted Support Schools (ATSI)*

Alabama identifies a school as consistently underperforming if a subgroup of the school is performing below the 75th percentile of the schools identified for Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) and has not shown improvement for three (3) years.

Any school with one or more consistently underperforming subgroup(s) will be identified annually for Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI).

Any school from among the schools identified as TSI, with a subgroup that performs below the threshold for the “all students” group is considered low performing and will be identified at least once every three years for Additional Targeted Support and Improvement (ATSI).

*Exit Criteria*

A school identified for CSI support may exit such status after three years if the school performs above the bottom 5% of schools receiving Title I, Part A funds and shows improvement as compared to when the school was originally identified. Schools previously identified as CSI based on their graduation rate must have a graduation rate at or above 67% to exit CSI status.

A school identified for Additional Targeted Support and Improvement (ATSI) support may exit such status after three years if the school no longer meets the eligibility criteria for targeted support and demonstrates improved performance as compared to performance at the time of identification for the student subgroup for which the school is identified.
